Attached you will find an application for the Anchorage AEYC Early Childhood Scholarship for Early Childhood Education degrees, certificates, and conferences. Stage One:

- The application packets will be evaluated by the Anchorage AEYC Scholarship committee.
- Scholarship candidates will be notified for an interview after the Stage One review.
- The application deadline is: December 31st, March 31st, June 30th and September 30th.

Stage Two:

• Scholarship candidates will be interviewed.

Stage Three:

• Scholarship candidates will be notified by the Anchorage AEYC Scholarship committee.

Stage Four:

- Scholarship recipients are expected to do one or more of the following tasks:
 - Write up a brief summary of the course/courses you attended for the Anchorage AEYC newsletter.
 - $\circ~$ Give an hour of volunteer time to the Anchorage AEYC organization.
 - Give a small presentation at an Anchorage AEYC Board meeting (3-5 minute verbal summary of the conference, poster board display, etc.).
