Stage Four:

- *Scholarship recipients are expected to do two or more of the following tasks:*
 - *Write up a brief summary of the course/courses you attended for the AAEYC website and to be included in the final Conference Program. Please include photos of yourself and/or experience.*
 - *Volunteer time to the AAEYC organization. Minimum 1 hour.*
 - *Give a small presentation at an AAEYC Board meeting (3-5 minutes verbal summary of the conference, poster board display, etc.).*
 - *Write a thank you letter to the AAEYC Board stating how the scholarship impacted you. Address letter to: AAEYC, c/o C&C Services, PO Box 771884, Eagle River, AK 99577*
