
A PICNIC IN THE PARK







They put the picnic basket here




next to a long bench where they sat down to take off their shoes and socks.




Beside the bench was a shallow pool for sailing small boats and wading.




Taking Eric's boat with them, they walked around like this....to some steps at the edge of the pool, and they waded into the water.




Here they are, Christopher.... and Elizabeth...and Eric.




The breeze was just right on that summer day. It caught the sails, and the boat flew across the water like this.




Then they slowly pulled it back with a string attached to the stern.




The boat sailed to and fro like this....for quite a long time until their stomachs told them it was time to eat.

Then they put on their socks and shoes and started home like this.....The park was the same as they found it, except for this beautiful butterfly that had joined them on their picnic.


A WALK IN THE WOODS


(Fall)

It was a bright fall afternoon, a perfect day to take a walk in fact. Kate whistled for her dog, Ginger, and they started off.


At the end of the street there was a woods, and a path ran through the woods like this..... Kate started down the path, looking this way and that.

There were many things to see. To the left stood a maple tree with leaves of brilliant, flaming red.







Then, plop! Over here a hickory nut fell from its tree.




A bushy-tailed squirrel pounced on the nut and scampered across the path to bury it here.

I went to the park to see if I could find him.




When I got to the park I accidentally stepped in a pile of bumblebees. the bees swarmed all around me.




I wanted to get away from the bees so I jumped in a pond of water.


I still needed to find Bingo, so I ran to the top of a tall hill.
















KRISTEN RAE'S FIRST CIRCUS


It was a perfect summer day, the special day that Kristen Rae had thought would never come. But at last she and her mother were inside the big tent. Kristen has come to see her first circus.




This is the main ring where all sorts of exciting things are about to happen.




Kristen is sitting in a section of seats over here. It's the best spot to see everything.



Opposite is the bandstand. Crash! Bang! The music begins to play.





The show starts with a parade. The clowns tumble along like this....playing tricks on their way,



and here come elephants dancing and horses prancing, like this.....


Now some performers begin to climb to the top of the tent here.... and there....






Ladders on each side take them higher to a tightrope way up here.


Kristen holds her breath as a man pedals across on one wheel.






She is glad that there is a safety net underneath.


Next, in a cage right here an animal trainer performs with snarling lions and tigers,






and nearby two trained seals balance balls on their noses.

Next the trapeze act begins, and the stars of the circus fly through the air, up and over, like this.....











Open the paper and push the tab to the reverse side thereby reversing fold 2.




Pinch and pull the pop-up tab from the inside. Close and press folds.








SKY WATCHING



When they built the planetarium on High Street, Tommy's father said it looked as if a giant had turned over his cereal bowl.














His friends, Marc and Sara, also lived on High Street in a house here....Like Tommy they wanted to learn more about what went on in the sky.




So on the night that the planetarium opened, Tommy, Marc, and Sara were the first ones inside. They are sitting together here.




Soon the other seats were filled.....
The lights went off, and the show began.




First some strange, rough mountains appeared.




Then a bright ball seemed to rise from behind the mountains....No, it wasn't the moon. It was the earth as it appears from the landscape of the moon.




Next the dome of the planetarium was sprinkled with tiny, sparkling lights. To Tommy and his friends they looked just like this.....They couldn't tell one from another.




It helped when a bright arrow pointed here.... and here.... and there....




The program lasted almost an hour, and it was dark outside when the audience left. The kids looked up at the sky hoping to see some familiar stars, but all they could see is a big round moon.




"The moon is too bright," said Tommy. "We won't be able to see many stars. But I can sure see the face on the moon." He was right. The face was much clearer than usual.



"I guess there's nothing special to see," he said, "so we might as well go home." Tommy crossed the street to his house,




and Marc and Sara crossed the street to their house.




Too bad! If they had waited one minute more, this is what they would have seen....I know what this strange creature is thinking. "What a way to great a visitor from outer space!"
